#### Specifications

Headroom, acceleration, fuel economy, and towing capacity (for luxury utility vehicles) are among the 30 or so specifications listed for each Lexus vehicle produced.

#### Tire Information

Find the original brands and sizes of tires put on a vehicle at the factory, including the tire code which specifies the quality tire specially selected by Lexus for the vehicle.

#### Total Units Produced

Find out how many vehicles Lexus made each year for each model, including breakdown between automatic and manual transmissions.

#### Original Pricing and Options

Find out the manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP) for vehicles and factory options when the vehicles first went on sale.

#### Colors and Color Codes

Find out what exterior colors were offered for each vehicle and the color code. The color code is the paint "recipe" for the color and can be used to obtain the correct touch-up paint for your vehicle from your dealer.
